- Who are you making known by your thoughts, words, and actions?
- We all make known someone or something by what we do and say. When you do something selfless for your spouse, you are making love known to him or her. When you curse, you are making profanity and crudeness known to the world. The examples are endless.
- This week, we continue our discussion around Holy Moments as the best possible way to make Jesus known in the world today
- St. Augustine once wrote that we each have the ability to make the “invisible God visible.” And that’s exactly what Holy Moments do. They make the invisible God visible to world surrounding that action and beyond.
- It can sound like a daunting task, to make the invisible God visible. It can seem like a daunting task to answer the call of the Christian life to be Holy.
